The logo for World Youth Day 2011 in Madrid was presented this week. The image reflects youth of the world beneath the cross, united to form the crown of Our Lady, patron of Madrid.

The logo designer said the image symbolizes "youth of the whole world united to celebrate their faith together with the Pope, at the foot of The crown, forms the "M" of Mary and of Madrid. And the cross, symbol of Christianity, presides over the event.

The message of the logo, the designer continued, is "a catechesis, an opportunity for evangelization: The quick and sure path to reach Christ is the Virgin Mary, Mother of God and of mankind. In Mary's faith, youth have the example and model for reaching Christ and fulfilling the primary goal of World Youth Day: to bring their message to the world."
