-This Sunday is **Trinity Sunday**. Perhaps we could find and pray with the beautiful icon of the Trinity with which you are all familiar. Not only is it appropriate for this feast but it is also appropriate for the Eucharistic Congress as it shows the three figures of the Trinity seated around a table. The figures seem to invite the “viewer” to come in and share this meal with them.

-Monday is a Bank Holiday so Mass will be at **11.00 am**.

-Next Sunday the final Mass of the “**Do This in Memory of Me**” programme takes place at 12.00. **The Children’s liturgy** will take place at this Mass also.

-**Our final Novena in preparation for the Congress** will take place in this Church during the **7.00 pm vigil Mass, next week, the 9th June**. The speaker at the Mass will be Mary Gilmer, a member of the Pastoral Parish Council and she will also lead us in a short period of prayer and Exposition after the Mass.

-The **Community Care Group**, who celebrated 40 years of devoted service to the people of Ballyroan, are appealing for your help. This group was set up by Roisin O’Looney who, together with 25 other young mothers at the time, to provide child care for mothers and later to help the old, the sick, the housebound. In 1981 the Meals on Wheels was set up and they are **now looking for volunteers** who have about an hour or two to spare each week and who would be willing to keep this service going. If you are interested in becoming a driver or helping with the preparation of food please give your name into the community centre.

-There will be an “**Open Garden**” at **40 Templeroan Avenue, Knocklyon Road** on Saturday and Sunday the 9th and 10th June in aid of the Sam McMahon Trust and Friedreich’s Ataxia Research Alliance. Admission is €5.00. Tea, coffee and home-made goodies will be available.

-This Monday, Archbishop Martin will ordain eight permanent deacons for ministry in the diocese. These candidates have been preparing for the voluntary ordained ministry for the past four years. There will be a presentation on the diaconate in the Iona Centre, Knocklyon on 14th June at 7.30 for those interested in hearing more about it.
