#### This Week's Calendar

<u>Tue.</u> 14<sup>th</sup>: St. Callistus 1, pope and martyr. After a life of slavery and imprisonment for criminal offences, Callistus was freed and became a deacon in charge of the catacombs that bear his name.

Wed. 15th: St. Teresa of Avila, virgin and doctor of the Church. Teresa was deeply contemplative, highly active and practical, established Carmelite convents under a reformed rule, and wrote much on prayer and the spiritual life. She is patron of lace-makers and headache sufferers.

<u>Fri</u> 17<sup>th</sup>: St. Ignatius of Antioch, bishop and martyr. He urged Christians to unite in and through the Eucharist and around their local bishop and he died a martyr at Rome.

<u>Sat 18<sup>th</sup></u>: St. Luke, Evangelist. Luke, the author of the third Gospel is patron of butchers, book-binders, doctors and surgeons, artists and glassworkers.
