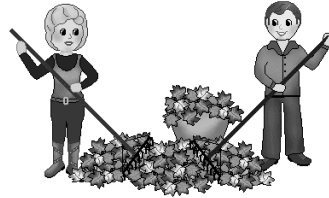
-The U3A are hosting a Floral Demonstration in the Ruah Centre on Monday from 10.00 – 12.00. All are welcome.
