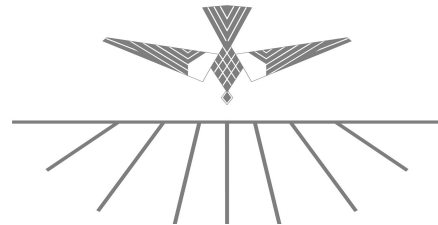

**WORKING TOGETHER FOR MISSION**

For several years now grouping of neighbouring parishes have been working more closely together so that the mission of the Church can be more effectively carried out.

There are several reasons for this: we live in changing times, our Christian and Catholic faith seems to mean less to more people as time passes and the rapidly declining numbers of ageing clergy.

The Ballyroan, Churchtown and Rathfarnham grouping of parishes have been working towards greater co-operation and shared ministry with each other. For over two years now the Area Team of the three parishes has been meeting on a regular basis. While we aim to provide a more unified and shared ministry, each parish will still retain its own unique traditions and individuality. One of the first initiatives of the grouping was the production of the quarterly Newsletter, the BCR Parish News. Over that time, we have begun the process of parish clergy informally rotating between the parishes for Masses, etc.

Having consulted with the Area Team, with effect from 23<sup>rd</sup>/24<sup>th</sup> November, this rotation will be formalised. While this development will involve clergy moving much more between the parishes, it will provide a greater variety of celebrants while at the same time each priest will continue to reside in the parish assigned to him by the Archbishop.

**REMEMBRANCE OF FATHER JK O'SULLIVAN**

The annual Mass of Remembrance for diocesan clergy who have died during the year, including a former priest of this parish, Father JK O'Sullivan, will take place in the Pro-Cathedral at 10.30 on Saturday, 9<sup>th</sup> November.
