Church Seating

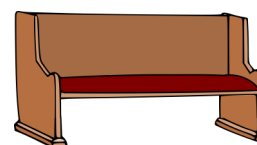
The current covid guidelines for churches state that a church can have up to 50% capacity. In this church, that means we can have up to 500 people at any Mass.

To keep people safe, we have closed off every second seat which will ensure that we will still have a safe distance between rows.

We would ask people sitting in the same seat and not from the same household to spread out along the seat ensuring additional safety.

By closing every second seat we are hoping that people who are anxious about returning to the church will feel safer knowing we are continuing to take measures to keep everyone safe.

We would ask you please not to remove the ribbons from the closed off seats, and we will continue to monitor the covid guidelines.



Booking of Masses

We will always endeavour to facilitate Anniversary / Special Intention Masses on the dates requested if possible. However, in the event of a funeral taking place on the requested day, we will arrange the Mass for an alternative date.

It is therefore important that when booking a Mass, a contact name and phone number is provided so that we can advise of the change in date, thereby avoiding disappointment and upset to people.
