The Gospel of John.

Have you noticed that our Gospel readings since Easter, have been from the Gospel of John. This was the last of the four Gospels in the New Testament, completed probably in the 90s. Scholars believe that the followers of the 'beloved disciple' John the son of Zebedee, one of the twelve apostles were the authors. It is a masterpiece of ancient literature, it is both poetic and spiritual. Can I suggest you read the Gospel from start to finish over the next few weeks. You can also use this Gospel when you pray. Notice a phrase or sentence that strikes your attention. Perhaps God has a message for you in the

words. Repeat them slowly.... Examples: 6:44 no one can come to me unless he is drawn by the father who sent me. 6:53 if you do not eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you will not have life in you. 13:34 I give you a new commandment: love one another; just as I have loved you. 14:1 Do not let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God still, and trust in me.
