CHURCH SEATING

We have now completed the process of spreading out the church seats, leaving a bigger distance between each row. This makes it much safer and easier for people to enter and exit the seats.

The capacity of the church prior to this project was 800-1000 people depending on how close people sit together. The capacity now is approximately 670 people and again, could be more, depending on how many are in each seat. This is more than enough to cater for the current attendance at the weekends.

The removal of some seats from the back of the church has resulted in the creation of a large, open space which will be more comfortable for people when leaving the church or when funerals are taking place.

Some of the seats that had to be removed had memorial plaques on them and, in addition, many of the seats have had to be re-numbered. Please do not be concerned if you currently cannot find your plaque as all plaques that had to be removed are being carefully stored and will be replaced on another seat in the same location in due course.

Please also note that the wheelchair/parent and child spaces will be retained in their current locations within the church.

Many thanks to Michael Curtin and James Perkins for undertaking the task of spacing out the seats.

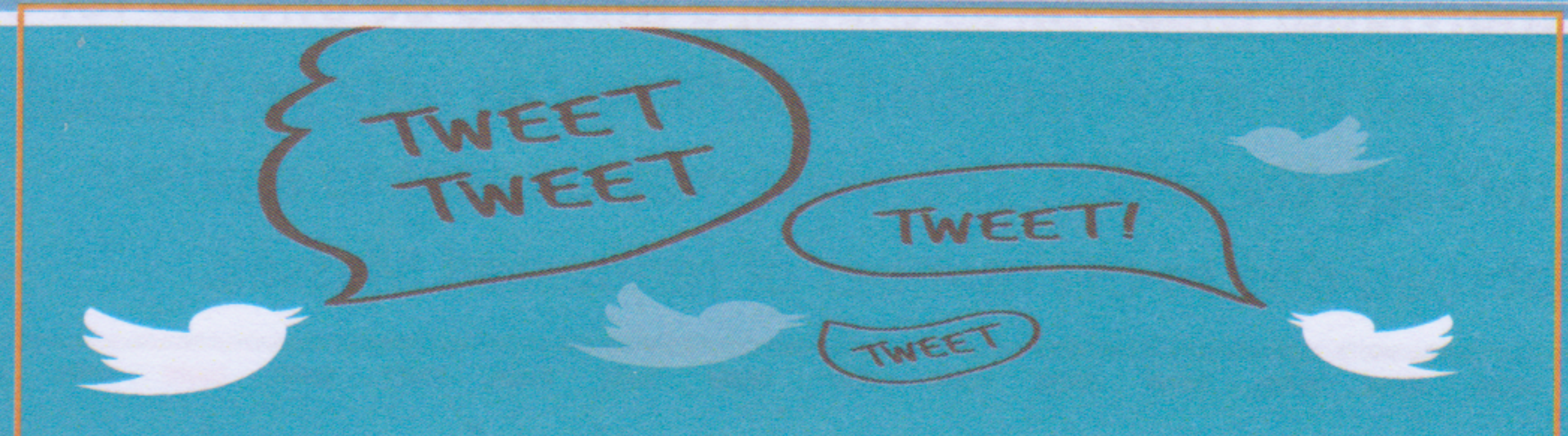
