Gospel for this week

As we are in the Sunday Cycle (3), our Gospel reading is from St Luke. Chapter 12:49-

53 Luke continues the theme about discipleship but also writes how Jesus warns about the challenges that this will entail.

What do the following words mean for you?

'I am here to bring ...division!'

Jesus refers to another baptism that he must experience- a baptism of fire- a trial of faith, one that will lead to his humiliation, torture and death. But for his followers, (us today) victory over death and a reason to have hope and faith no matter what trials we face.

But living the Gospel message faithfully, is no easy task- some will pick and mx, while others will reject the message entirely and deride those who openly profess a faith in a loving God.
