Our Gospel reading this week is from St Luke. Chapter 17:11-19

The well-known story of the cure of the ten lepers is only found in Luke's Gospel. The **theme is about God's mercy and salvation.**

The word leprosy is a translation of a Hebrew word that included many skin conditions. But any one with such a condition was ritually impure and so to be avoided.

The key phrase for me is when Jesus addresses the leper who thanked him for being healed and said to him **'go on your way your faith has made you well.'** The Greek word for 'made you well' has two meanings, both to heal and to save. Jesus by showing mercy and curing the ten lepers has not just healed them physically but he has allowed them to be part of the community again.

Are we open to the mercy of God in our lives, and in turn willing to show mercy and love to others and have we the faith to trust in God no matter what life throws at us?
