Our Gospel reading is from Luke Chapter. 24:13
-35. 'The Road to Emmaus'

This story is only found in the Gospel of Luke, and it describes another resurrection appearance of Jesus. You could consider reading it a few times and appreciate the remarkable narrative skill in how many stories of Jesus' life, death and resurrection are woven together in our Gospel story today. You might like to take time to reflect on all four Gospel accounts of the resurrection of Jesus. While we may not know the exact details of what the disciples

experienced, we do know it changed their lives. St Paul's account of the resurrection and his own experience is well worth reading, it's in his first letter to the Corinthians Ch 15:1-11. Can you imagine how they felt to experience Jesus again in their lives. "Were not our hearts burning in within us while he was talking to us on the road..."

Perhaps we can take time this week to listen and open our hearts to the Spirit of Jesus.
