Our Gospel reading is from Matthew Chapter. 10:37-42.

Last week we read how Jesus encouraged his disciples, by telling them not be afraid because their loving 'Father' will be with them, no matter what trials they may face. This week the message is that it will be challenging to be a follower of Christ, particular for the first Christians when their faith was persecuted by those in authority. There may be crosses to bear, opposition even from relatives and neighbours. The Gospel regularly uses exaggeration to make the point, that we must love Jesus above all else and live our lives in how he asked us to do.

Love God, forgive our enemies and care for the poor and marginalised. We will then enjoy our eternal reward! What do the words mean for you? 'Whoever receives you, receives me, and whoever receives me receives the one who sent me.'


