Our Gospel reading is from Matthew Chapter. 11:25-30.

Last week we read how Jesus told his followers that there may be challenges and crosses to bear. This week the message is that discovering the gift of faith does not require one to be clever or learned, but to be humble, and trust in our loving God, just as a child instinctively trusts their parents. There is a sense in this Gospel that Jesus is now fully convinced of who he is and what his mission is, 'all things have been handed over to me by my Father.' Jesus is calling us too, to an intimacy with the Father, through him the Son and by the gift of the Holy Spirit.

What do the words mean for you? 'Come to me, all you who labour and are overburdened, and I will give you rest.'
