Let us take time to reflect on the Stations of the Cross during the rest of Lent.....

7th Station: Jesus falls a second time –
We adore you, O Christ and we bless you, because by your holy cross you have redeemed the world
Lord, when faced with failure and disappointments, help us not to hide behind self-pity, withdrawing from you and others. Grant us the hope we need to move forward and not be afraid to begin again.
8th Station: Jesus comforts the women of Jerusalem-
Even though his closest friends had abandoned him and he was being led to his death, the Lord still had the sensitivity to feel for others. Lord, grant me your compassion.
9th Station: Jesus falls for the third time –
The forgiveness of God always offers us a new beginning.
10th Station: Jesus is stripped of his garments-
With the words we say, we can strip people down so that they feel very small, or we can build them up to what they can become. Lord, help us to use words wisely.
