Feasts and Anniversaries for this Week

28th 1914 - Assassination of Archduke Franz Ferdinand and his wife in Sarajevo - began process that lead to WW I

29th Feast of St. Peter and St. Paul

29th 1900 Birth of Antoine de Saint-Exupery author of the Little Prince

1st - St. Oliver Plunkett : Had been teaching theology in Rome for 12 years when he was appointed Archbishop of Armagh in 1669. His work in Ireland were marked by a strong commitment to the truth, loyalty and obedience to the Holy See, a spirit of self-denial as he faced opposition and physical deprivation and a concern to end dissensions. He was executed in Tyburn in 1681.

1st - 1918 Pop Up Toaster announced, invented by Charles Strite.

3rd - St. Thomas (apostle) : is said to have preached the gospel in India where he was martyred. The faith that led him to know Christ in his wounds also sent him to the farthest places to preach Christ.
