

The word "synodal" means journeying together and this questionnaire and meeting is an opportunity for all young and older people-to share and listen to each other's experience of being a Catholic today.

Why are you being invited? Pope Francis has asked all of us to take part in sharing and listening to each other and to the Holy Spirit, in the hope that we can begin to lay foundations for the future of our parish and the Irish Church together.

Eventually, all the responses will be sent to the Archbishop of Dublin and collected in time for the 2023 Bishop's Synod in Rome.

What will happen with the feedback and at the meeting n 30th March? Moira and Frank have been trained to lead the gatherings in a reflective, prayerful atmosphere. 4 Questions will be presented, and people can sit in small groups. It is not a debate but a sharing and listening exercise.


