Our Gospel reading is from Mark 10: 2-16

'Let the little children come to me.'

Jesus' teaching on marriage and divorce needs to be seen in the historical context of his time. The Jewish divorce laws allowed for women to be put out of the family home and face the inevitable hardships that would follow. When Jesus refers to letting the children come to him and receiving 'kingdom of God' as a little child, he is highlighting how we must all value the dignity of the most vulnerable. The child displays qualities of openness, trust and gratitude, these are qualities we need to possess if our faith and trust in our loving God is to grow.

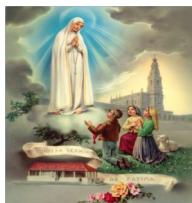
